Vermont's five Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) —

including Senior Solutions, which serves Windham and

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Windhamsor counties, among others — administer the State 12 Health Insurance Assistance Program ("SHIP")7. SHIP offerings 13 free, unbiased, and confidential health insurance counselingg, 14 including assistance with Medicare Plan changes, for individuals, 15 their families, and caregivers-during annual open enrollment. 16 The annual Medicare open enrollment period runs from 17 Oct. 15 through Dec. 7. This is the time for Medicare 18 beneficiaries to review and make changes to their coverage. With 19 the reduction in available Medicare Advantage plans, Area-20 Agencies on Asging expect a significant increase in the number 21 of Vermont Medicare beneficiaries seeking SHIP open enrollment 22 appointments to make plan changes. SHIP programs are funded and regulated under the 24 federal Administration for Community Living (ACL) and the 25 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Each year, 26 SHIP programs assist more than 6,000 Vermonters in choosing 27 the most cost-effective Medicare Plan to meet healthcare needs. 28 AAA SHIP counselors say they will schedule as many 29 open enrollment appointments as possible, while serving the **30** most vulnerable beneficiaries with complex plan changes, and 31 those eligible for low-income programs. They are also increasing the number of SHIP volunteers and interns to provide general 33 information and assistance to callers. 34 AAAs may refer beneficiaries directly to Medicare.gov or 35 1-800-Medicare (1-800-633-4227) for enrollment assistance. 1-36 800-Medicare is staffed 24/7 and can assist with your enrollment 37 needs. 38 39 Vermont's population is the third oldest-state in the nation, with 155,000 Medicare beneficiaries. 40 "Vermonters are feeling the impact of fewer Medicare insurance plans coupled with an increasing need for many other 42 services for older and disabled Vermonters," Statewide SHIP 43 Director Sam Carleton said in a news release. 44 Carleton added that "federal funding for SHIP programs 45 has been reduced or remained flat year over year while the

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nation's aging demographic has grown, with 11,000 baby 47 boomers turning 65 every day.
