22 Bach's Flute Sonata in E major, on piano; Haydn's Trio in G
23 major; Roussel's "Deux poèmes de Ronsard"; and Martins Trio.

24 The concert is led by Bart Feller, Alex's friend and former
25 student. Feller is a graduate of the Curtis Institute of Music and
26 current faculty at The Julliard School Pre-College and Rutgers
27 University. He is also the principal flute of the New Jersey
28 Symphony.

29 Feller will be joined by longtime friends and colleagues
30 of Alex: Alison Hale and Robin Matathias, flute; Kathy Andrew,
31 violin; Judith Serkin, cello; Greg Hayes and Susan Dedell, piano;
32 and soprano Junko Watanabe.
