4 The second installment of the 2025 Brattleboro Real  
5 Estate and Personal Property Taxes will be due by 5 p.m. on  
6 Monday, Nov. 17. Payments made after that date will have 1%  
7 interest added to the unpaid balance.

8 Town utility bills are also due by 5 p.m. Payments made  
9 subsequently will have an additional 1% interest, as well as an  
10 8% penalty, added to the unpaid balance.

11 Payments can be mailed to the Town of Brattleboro, 230  
12 Main St., Suite 111, Brattleboro, VT 05301. An official postmark  
13 of Nov. 17 will be considered an on-time payment.

14 Payments can also be made by dropping an envelope  
15 containing your check (no cash) into the drop box in the parking  
16 lot behind the Municipal Center.

17 Payments dropped in the drop box after hours on the due  
18 date will not be considered on time. Be sure to include the  
19 quarterly payment stub to ensure your payment is applied  
20 properly.

21 Electronic bank checks must be received in the office by  
22 the due date. Electronic bank checks dated for the due date, but  
23 received after the due date, will not be considered an on time  
24 payment. Check with your bank regarding payment schedule.

25 You may also choose to make payments via a credit card  
26 or debit card at [Brattleboro.gov](http://Brattleboro.gov). This month, the Finance  
27 Department launched a new online platform for paying utility  
28 bills. Customers can establish recurring or one-time payments  
29 with a debit or credit card or by entering their bank information.

30 After registering, customers can elect to receive email  
31 statements only or continue to receive notices in the mail. There  
32 is a fee for this service.

33 The town can also accept credit card payments at the  
34 office over the counter; fees do apply.

35 If you choose to pay in person, the Finance Department's  
36 hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. in Room  
37 111 of the Municipal Building.
