Southeast School District (WSESD) board members, and  
Representative Town Meeting members are available at the Town  
Clerk's Office Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to noon  
and 1 to 5 p.m., after Dec. 15.  
Before that date, petitions will only be available between  
the hours of 9 a.m. and noon.

11 Town elections will be held Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at  
12 the American Legion, 32 Linden St. Annual Representative Town  
13 Meeting is scheduled to begin Saturday, March 21, 2026, at 8:30  
14 a.m. in the Brattleboro Union High School Gymnasium. If the  
15 voters of Brattleboro choose to discontinue Representative Town  
16 Meeting during Town elections, an Open Town Meeting will be  
17 held Saturday, April 11, 2026, in the BUHS Gymnasium.

18 Petitions for Town Officers and WSESD Brattleboro Board  
19 Members must contain at least 30 valid signatures of registered  
20 Brattleboro voters and be filed in the Town Clerk's Office no later  
21 than Monday, Jan. 26, 2026, at 5 p.m. to have their name placed  
22 on the ballot.

23 Candidates for Town Meeting Member must file a  
24 nomination petition, issued by the Town Clerk's Office, with at  
25 least 10 valid signatures of voters from the district where the  
26 candidate lives no later than 5 p.m. Monday, Jan. 26. Incumbents  
27 for Town Meeting Member will be mailed a Notice of Intent form  
28 in early January and must return their signed Notice of Intent  
29 form no later than 5 p.m. Monday, Jan. 26.
