29 and strengthening his position.

30       Trump would not be able to get away with his  
31 destruction of our Republic without the active support and  
32 financing of the billionaire oligarchs who are profiting from his  
33 policies.

34       Zuckerberg, Bezos, Musk, Singer, Schwarzman, and Thiel  
35 are just a few of the billionaires who have jumped on the MAGA  
36 bandwagon. The media moguls have fired or denied access to  
37 voices of dissent. The profiteers who benefit from the Trump  
38 agenda kick back millions to Trump and his organization, a  
39 regular orgy at the feeding trough of the pigs of capitalism.

40       No crime or assault against the Constitution is too great  
41 for these oligarchs to stomach, as long as they can grow their  
42 already-obscene piles of money.

44       ALTHOUGH TRUMP is enriching them, the oligarchs  
45 ultimately depend on us to buy and use their products. Without  
46 our dollars, they would wither and die on their golden vine.

72 In short, Americans seem to be saying, "We don't  
73 approve of the destruction of our political system, but we are not  
74 capable of doing anything to change our own conduct, because  
75 we are so busy and they make our purchasing easier. If we can't  
76 do it with a click on the screen, then it's more than we can  
77 handle right now."

79 WE ARE FACING a violent coup d'état, but we want it to  
80 end without any real effort on our part.

81           Stopping Trump will require that we boycott MAGA-  
82   supportive corporations and that we will go on consumer strikes  
83   where we buy nothing at all. It will require us to harass our  
84   politicians daily until they shed their lethargy and their  
85   attachment to the corporate money stream. And it will require  
86   some of us to be arrested, injured, or killed in the line of duty,  
87   which is to stand up for our country and each other.

88           We have been spoiled in this country. Since the Civil  
89   War, we have not had any armed conflicts on our soil. We gave

112   government an interest-free loan to do its dirty work)?

114           WHAT WILL IT TAKE for America to fully realize that we,  
115 like the proverbial frog, are now treading simmering water that

117           It's time to stop pretending that this is anything other than  
118 an emergency. It is time to accept that if we don't act, we will all  
119 be living an unfree life where neighbor is pitted against neighbor,  
120 prejudices are encouraged and inflamed, trust is destroyed, and  
121 the American dream is not just a difficult distant goal, but will  
122 instead be a nightmare of greed, violence, and race hatred.

123           The breathtaking pace at which we are barreling down  
124 into this rathole should convince us that this grim prediction is  
125 not something that lies in our children's or grandchildren's future,  
126 but is just around the corner. Each one of us will be bearing the  
127 full effects of our failure to act. Our current discomfort will be  
128 nothing compared to what lies ahead.

129           For generations, we have embraced the myths of  
130 Americans' can-do attitude and our indomitable defense of our  
131 freedom in the face of adversity. Can we step up and actually  
132 take actions that align with these myths? Or will we find that we  
133 are just as hollow as our claims of a classless society and of  
134 freedom and justice for all?
