2 Bo Foard and David Manning have closed the diner's

3 doors and are selling the property

5 After two years running it, Royal Diner co-owner Bo  
6 Foard and partner David Manning have closed its doors and are  
7 quietly talking to folks who've expressed interest in buying the  
8 building it's in.

9 "It's been a pleasure, but we're moving on," said Foard  
10 by phone on Jan. 19, noting there was not a particular issue or

11 problem; the time had just come for him to wrap it up at the  
12 Marlboro Road property.

13 "I just kind of reached the end of what I thought I could  
14 do there," he said. "The energy the place needed to make it move  
15 forward. I tried really hard to staff it, and that's really hard in this  
16 environment."

17 He called Manning and said, "You know, I think I'm  
18 done."

19 "It was a quick decision," Foard said. "I think it's time to  
20 create businesses for someone else, but we've had a lot of fun.  
21 And I reached a point where it wasn't fun anymore, and we're  
22 moving on."

23 While he doesn't participate in social media, Foard did  
24 get a friend to post for him and he's aware of the various and  
25 vocal opinions about his tenure and the closure.

26 "There's a lot of Monday morning quarterbacking about  
27 what should be done there," said Foard. "I love the restaurant  
28 business, but I don't have the bandwidth to do what I was doing  
29 at the Diner long term."

30 Foard still co-owns The Porch restaurant on Putney Road  
31 in Brattleboro with Gretchen Hardy, the hands-on manager there.

32 He is also owner and founder of Foard Panel, Inc., which  
33 designs, manufactures, and installs structural insulating panels.

34 Foard said the Royal Diner has "some seasonality to it"  
35 but that it's been packed, especially in summer. And he's enjoyed  
36 the ride.

37 "I had awesome customers and friends, and we've had a  
38 lot of fun. I made the decision so fast I can't believe I did it, but I  
39 was really confident my time there was ended," he said.

40 "I think we've set the stage for the next person," Foard  
41 said. "We've done a ton of work there, and the physical plant is  
42 always going to need work. It's a 1937 Worcester dining car.  
43 What makes it funky and cool also makes it challenging."

44 Foard said he and Manning have had "a ton of inquiries  
45 and shown it more than a few times" and are hopeful one of

46 those folks will take it on. If not, the partners intend to list the  
47 property with a real estate agent.

48 "Somebody's going to have to have the financial  
49 wherewithal to take this on," he said. "I'm more than willing to  
50 help out new owners. We've put a lot of sweat equity into the  
51 place and we're pretty proud of it and I was really happy with my  
52 staff and the food we produced."

53 But "it just got to the end for me and I have so many  
54 things going on," he said. "This didn't go the way I wanted it to."

55 "I think I was looking for the next *Gretchen*, and it didn't  
56 happen," he said with a laugh.

57 Foard wants folks to know what's happening with the  
58 diner's old neon sign.

59 "A lot of people ask, 'Where is the neon sign?', which we  
60 got working for the first time in, like, 10 years," he said. "This  
61 spring someone came in and said, 'Your sign's on fire.'

62 Thanks to Dennis Tier, of Deni and Bev Tier Signs in  
63 Dummerston, "that sign's going to be totally restored, like brand  
64 new."

65 "I look forward to the new owners having this  
66 masterpiece," Foard said.
