8 performing *Heisenberg: The Uncertainty Principle*, a play by  
9 Simon Stephens, an award winning contemporary British  
10 playwright.

11 The play is set in London and tells the story of an  
12 unfolding chance encounter and a relationship between a 42-  
13 year-old woman and a 75-year-old man.

14 *Heisenberg* is “the quintessential Valentine’s Day drama,”  
15 said organizers in a new release, “a chance to witness a life-  
16 altering moment between two strangers amidst the frantic energy  
17 of a London train station.” Through a sharp and comical sparring  
18 match, the play explores the unpredictable human connections  
19 that can shift the course of our lives forever.

20 Stephens has authored more than 20 stage plays and has  
21 written English versions of foreign plays, radio plays, and  
22 adaptations from novels such as *The Curious Incident of the Dog*  
23 *in the Night-Time* by Mark Haddon. That adaptation won the  
24 2015 Tony Award, Best Play; the Olivier award for best new play  
25 in 2013, and other international awards.

26 Tiny Theater is a local acting ensemble for actors learning  
27 and performing their craft through reality-based acting techniques  
28 derived from the Group Theater and its founding members. It is  
29 under the direction of Robert Marcus.
