5 a 2004 filmed performance of the play *The Equivalent Lands* by
6 Joe Greenhoe at Next Stage on Sunday, Feb. 22, at 2 p.m. A brief
7 introduction to the play by cast members Jim Bombicino, Jenny
8 Holan, and Mark Brown will provide some context to the play.

9 The play, written for the 1976 Bicentennial celebration,
10 depicts life on the northern frontier as settlers moved into what is

11 now southern Vermont during the 18th century land disputes
12 between New Hampshire and New York.

13 The story takes place in Putney, Dummerston, and
14 Westminster, where conflicts between supporters of the King of
15 England and those working toward independent governance
16 played out in the years and months prior to the battles of
17 Lexington and Concord. Those conflicts pitted neighbors against
18 each other. Ancestors of some of the characters in the play still
19 live in the area.

20 Admission is by a suggested \$10 donation. Proceeds will
21 go toward the Putney Historical Society. Next Stage is located at
22 15 Kimball Hill in downtown Putney. For information, call 802-
