14 Symphony Orchestra. He serves on the faculty of the Curtis
15 Institute of Music. He has been featured on many radio and
16 television specials, including *CBS Sunday Morning* and *ABC's*
17 *Nightline*.

18 Of local interest, Solzhenitsyn is a BMC alum; as a
19 young child, he studied with Chonghyo Shin.
