16 *Zaum* magazine, Chariot Press, Harpur Palate, Moria Literary  
17 Magazine, and *Snaggletooth Magazine*.

18 She has an American Voices Nomination from Scholastic  
19 Art & Writing Awards, is a 2025 Adroit Prizes Commended  
20 Writer, and organizers say she has been nominated for the 2026  
21 Pushcart Prize. Paris has interned at both Green Writers Press and  
22 the *Bennington Review*, working on their respective editorial

25 Bogart is a writer, editor, and wildlife biologist who  
26 gathers inspiration and imagery for her poetry by spending deep  
27 time in nature. She worked for 30 years for the U.S. Fish &

29 of poetry, *All That Sustains*, was published in 2022.
