7 April 11, at the BMC, 72 Blanche Moyse Way.

8 This season's third touring ensemble from "the classical
9 world's most coveted retreat" (*The New Yorker*) showcases four
10 outstanding singers. Bridget Esler, soprano; Chihiro Asano,
11 mezzo-soprano; and Patrick Bessenbacher, tenor; will perform

12 vocal works by Brahms, Schumann, and Britten, with pianist
13 Lydia Brown.

14 The 7 p.m. program will begin and end with Oliver
15 Neubauer, violin; Judith Serkin, cello; and Solomon Ge, piano;
16 playing two of Haydn's most inviting piano trios. Piano Trio in E-
17 flat minor, Hob. XV:31, is considered one of his most dramatic
18 and emotionally charged chamber works, composed during his
19 second London visit.

20 In contrast, Haydn's Piano Trio in C major, Hob. XV:27
21 exemplifies his mature chamber style, combining elegance, wit,
22 and inventive thematic development.
