5 Migrant Justice Center, a nonprofit that empowers immigrant
6 farmworkers to organize for economic justice and human rights.
7 The concert will be held at Main Street Arts, 35 Main St., Friday,
8 April 17, at 6:30 p.m.

9 Doozy Jane “breathes fresh life into classic sounds with
10 their four-part treble harmonies and contemporary feminist
11 existence,” wrote organizers in a news release. Inspired by vocal

12 harmonizers of popular music and Americana, Doozy Jane
13 performs compositions by primarily female, nonbinary, and queer
14 artists.

15 The quartet's repertoire is curated, arranged, and
16 sometimes composed by Anna Patton (clarinet, tenor guitar), and
17 features Sarah Hadley Yakir (fiddle), Julia Read (fiddle, guitar),
18 and Haley Anderson (bass).

19 Tickets are offered on a sliding scale of \$10–\$25, and
