4 Former Brattleboro Selectboard Chair Daniel Quipp has  
5 announced his candidacy for the Vermont House of  
6 Representatives seat in Windham-8, following Rep. Mollie  
7 Burke's decision not to seek re-election *[story, this issue]*.

8 In a April 17 news release, Quipp said he is running "to  
9 bring steady, collaborative leadership and strong constituent  
10 service to Montpelier."

11 "Brattleboro deserves a representative who listens  
12 carefully, works hard, and is focused on getting things done,"  
13 Quipp said. "I'm running to represent the entire community:  
14 working people, families, seniors, young people, business  
15 owners, artists, and everyone who wants this town and this state  
16 to be affordable, healthy, safe, and full of opportunity."

17 Quipp served from 2019 to 2025 on the Selectboard,  
18 helping lead the town through the pandemic, major public safety  
19 challenges, and long-term infrastructure planning.

20 He is a manager at Southeastern Vermont Community  
21 Action (SEVCA), helping Vermonters navigate housing instability,  
22 high energy costs, food insecurity, and other day-to-day  
23 pressures.

24 Quipp said voters can expect humility, curiosity, and a  
25 willingness to collaborate.

26 "I have valuable experience that will help me get off to a  
27 strong start, but being an effective legislator also means listening,  
28 learning, and building relationships," Quipp said. "I want this  
29 campaign to be a conversation with the people of Windham-8  
30 about the issues affecting their lives and the changes they want to  
31 see."

32 Quipp said his campaign will focus on affordability,  
33 housing, health care, safe communities, and protecting the  
34 qualities that make Brattleboro a place people want to build their  
35 lives.

36 "Too many people are working hard and still struggling,"  
37 he said. "I want to bring a practical, hopeful approach to  
38 Montpelier, one that takes problems seriously, values good  
39 information, and stays focused on making life better for the  
40 people we serve."

41 Brattleboro Selectboard Chair Oscar Heller is serving as  
42 Quipp's campaign manager.
