4 Southeastern Vermont Community Action (SEVCA) is
5 launching its 2026 Impact Report, documenting what they call “a
6 year shaped by organizational adaptation and continued
7 dedication to serving neighbors across Windham and Windsor
8 counties.”

9 In 2025, SEVCA staff report it provided 4,402 services to
10 3,342 individuals and 1,750 households. With nearly one in
11 eight residents across Windham and Windsor counties living in

12 need and overall funding declining, this impact demonstrates
13 SEVCA's ability to deliver meaningful results in critical areas such
14 as housing stability, homelessness prevention, home heating
15 assistance, early childhood education, weatherization, and
16 financial empowerment.

17 This report offers a snapshot of the organization's work
18 over the past year, reflecting both the depth of need in the region
19 and SEVCA's sustained commitment to meeting that need with
20 care, consistency, and purpose.

21 "We are not only responding to today but building for
22 tomorrow," Executive Director Joshua Davis said in a news
23 release. "We are investing in strengthening SEVCA so that we can
24 continue to serve as a reliable, foundational support for years to
25 come."
